**Contractions** are made up of two words. When two words are put together, at least one letter is left out. An **apostrophe** is used to replace the missing letter(s).

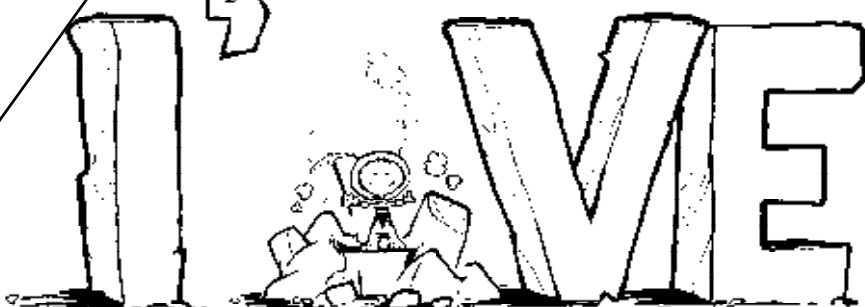

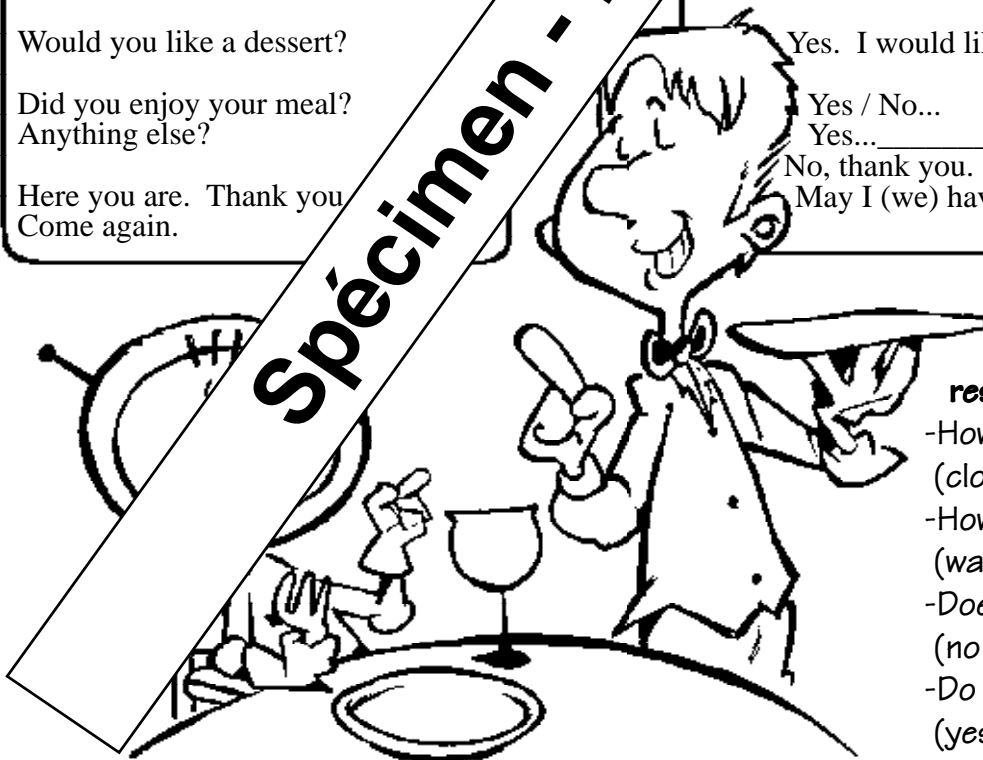
